We are so grateful the Lord has opened many doors of opportunity to serve here. Lynnell has had the chance to talk to a couple of her co-workers. They have been asking her questions. One of them stated they had visited Rheinland Baptist Church (RBC) years ago during a friend's baptism. **Please pray for Lynnell as she will be going back to work in August and for more chances to talk to her co-workers.**

We are thankful for the leadership of Pastor & Mrs. Wood as they have allowed us to work in the ministries at RBC. Rob has had opportunities to teach in Pastor Woody's Sunday school class and in Junior Church while the teacher was away. What an honor to serve our Saviour in these areas of ministry. It's been a joy to share God's word with these children. Many of them know their Bible. They were answering a lot of the questions from the lesson.



When the Dodson kids are not playing in the creek behind our house, they are continuing to serve in the ministries here. Brendan has been enjoying working in the sound booth. He has also started teaching Nolan to help when Rob is serving in other RBC ministries. The kids are still singing in the youth choir. This summer, an RBC couple started a music school for kids. Our children have been learning a lot and improving their talent for the Lord. Faith has been serving in the nursery along with Lynnell. Ryan has even been a part of Pastor Woody's illustrations.



Praise the Lord! Our household goods were finally delivered from Munich out of storage. The delay was due to waiting on our logistical support status. The Lord orchestrated everything. He allowed the customs review to be completed without any

issues. We are so blessed to have had Rheinland Moving & Storage at the house to help unload the container and get our goods into the house. It took less than 25 minutes to unload it.



Another praise was that we were finally able to register a vehicle which we had purchased back in February. It had been delayed due to job verification and pending paperwork. **Please pray as we are working on purchasing another car before Lynnell starts back to work at the middle school in August.**

Pastor Woody allowed us to start a fundraising program for the RBC campers going to Camp de Beho in Belgium. We took the idea of Rent-A-Teen from one of our former churches. This has given the RBC teens the chance to earn money to defray the cost of camp. It has been a huge success. They have been doing yard work, cleaning windows, washing cars, reorganizing storage closets, babysitting, and moving approximately 1620 liters of rubble from one location to another so it can be hauled away to the dump. We may change the name to Rent-A-Camper next year so our junior campers can get involved and earn money for camp. **Please pray for our junior and teen campers as they will be heading off to camp and also while they are there.**
